We recommend that we use these "Development" Meets as an opportunity to introduce new Officials and for continued training in new positions for our existing Technical Officials.

And as such we run these meets as we have our Tier 3 Meets.

16. Marketing

Quinton has been familiarising himself with the Online Tools and Databases and has begun standardising the SCWC image with the introduction of new email signatures, letterheads and presentation of the SCWC website. SOCIAL MEDIA- There has been immediate impact on our digital and social media presence with the introduction of the #WeAreSCWC Campaign across all platforms. A new "Sign Up" button has been enabled on the Facebook Page Quinton has worked to develop the "Club Finder" application, which is now live on the website- this is a feature that Swimming New Zealand attempted to develop a nationwide application for through supplier 'APT" in the UK and failed

18 & OVERS- A Facebook group has been set up for all 18 & over swimmers both past and present. This platform will provide a good base to launch and promote any upcoming events. A couple of social events are already being planned and the Inaugural 18 & over meet is booked at Jellie Park on the 25th September, and will be open to all 18 & overs . The SCWC Events Committee are on board and we are working alongside Darryl Foy (Timaru), and William Campbell (Wharenui). SNZ have set up a Tertiary database so participants can register for free as Recreational swimmer and enter the meet online. A The University of Canterbury Swim Sports Society has been founded with the initial AGM being held this weekend. Once started, the society will be funded by the University of Canterbury Students Association

Next steps- Set up meetings with the following groups to develop long term plans:

- Groups in South Canterbury and the West Coast in regards to how we can promote swimming in those regions

Expressions of interest have been called for by the CCC in relation to its current and planned aquatic facilities and all clubs were invited to make a submission. SCWC also made a submission. It was reiterated that MSF Should remain neutral ground with no "home" club and the CCC concur that this is not their desire either. Debbie to request this be put in writing as we have had many verbal assurances and clubs are concerned- these concerns need to be addressed. Martin advised that Linwood would not have a home club either. An email relating to the new Hornby Pool indicated that the CCC may reconsider their position regarding having a home club at this facility.	Board
