Conditions of Entry

1. All registered swimmers are eligible to enter
2. Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Technical Advisor prior to the commencement of the meet.
3. Age as at 23 February 2019
4. Entry Fees \$7.50 per individual event; \$12 per relay team
5. Online entries only. Entries close midnight Wednesday 13 February 2019
6. There will be no refunds on entry fees
7. Relay entries close midnight Thursday 14 February 2019 and are to be submitted by club recorders with a PDF file sent to secretary@waitahaswimclub.org.nz
8. Waitaha Swim Club reserves the right to restrict entries if necessary.
9. Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions.
10. Late entries will be at the Technical Advisor's discretion based on lane space availability. Late entry fee \$10.00 per event, swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points, these will be swum as exhibition swims only.
11. Confirmation of entries will be sent by Friday 15 February. Please check names, entries and events are correct on receipt of confirmation. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred.
12. Qualifying times are 25m times. Converted long course times may be used and times from unapproved meets are allowed. There are no qualifying times for Para athletes.
13. There are no qualifying times for the 400m Free, 400, IM and the 200m Butterfly but these are restricted to athletes 12 years of age and over. You must have qualified for an event at this meet to be eligible to enter these events. Please refer to the below table for the qualifying times

MEET RULES

General

1. The Waitaha Summer Sizzler is a Tier 1 event; swimmers must qualify according to the below table to enter.
2. The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations & By Laws, FINA Rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
3. Individual events will swum as timed finals, mixed gender, multi age group and seeded slowest to fastest
4. Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Advisor.
5. Electronic timing (touch pads & button backup) will be used at this meet with two timekeepers per lane.
6. Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
7. Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4 accompanied with the \$100.00 fee
8. Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
9. Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over the lane ropes.

Scratching's / Withdrawals

- 1 Scratchings must be submitted by 5pm Friday 22 February 2019 for 1st session and by close of Saturday session for Sunday, session 2.
- 2 Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the Clerk of Course (Marshall) at the appropriate time prior to their event and the withdrawal fee will apply
- 3 A \$20.00 fine will apply without excuse to all late or non scratching from events.

Warm Up

- 1 As per Swimming Canterbury West Coast warm-up procedure guidelines
(*Warm-up is the responsibility of the clubs, coaches and swimmers involved. **Officials are not** responsible for managing or controlling the warm-up procedures*)

Marshalling

- 1 Marshalling area will be advised prior to start of the event.
- 2 All swimmers must marshal for their events.
- 3 Swimmers should be in the marshaling area six (6) races prior to their event

Relays

- 1 All relays are mixed and must contain both genders and must consist of 2 males/2 females.
- 2 Age groups 14 years and under; 15 years & over.
- 3 Relay teams must comprise 4 swimmers
- 4 All relay swimmers must have entered an individual event at the meet
- 5 Swimmers must swim in one relay age group only; they may not swim in their own age relay and then up in the next age group relay.

Age Groups:

Individual Events: 13 years and under; 14 years; 15 years; 16 years and over
Relays: 14 & under and 15 & over

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd placegetters in each individual event. Towels to 1st place relay team, ribbons 2nd & 3rd place relay team.

Seating:

A seating plan will be sent to all participating clubs.

Officials: Officials Convenor to advise all those officiating at the meet that they are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees IOTS & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time. Earlier than the start of warm-up is preferable.

As per the Swimming New Zealand regulations there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be able to be classed as approved and for those times to be used for national qualification. Please refer for the attached sheet for details.
